### Hiking Trails

Dry Creek Trail 4.7 miles -West side of Shasta Dam

Fisherman's Point Trail 0.5 miles - East side of Shasta Dam

Packers Bay Trail System

1. **Waters Gulch Trail 2.8 miles** - Begins ½ mile before Packers Bay Parking Lot
2. **Overlook Trail 0.4 miles** - Begins ½ mile before Packers Bay Parking Lot
3. **Fish Loop Trail 0.7 miles** - Begins at Packers Bay Parking Lot
4. **East Side Trail 0.4 miles** - Begins at Shasta Marina's Boat Ramp

Bailey Cove Trail 3.1 miles - East side of McCloud Arm

Sugarloaf Trail 4 miles - West side of Sacramento Arm

Hirz Bay Trail 1.6 miles - Northwest McCloud Arm

Potem Falls Trail 0.3 miles - Near Pit 7 Dam

Clickapudi Trail 10 miles - Begins at Jones Valley Campground

Greens Creek Trail 6 miles - McCloud Arm, Greens Creek Boat-in Campground

Bully Hill Mine Remains - Squaw Creek Arm, between Town Creek & First Creek, North side

**Hirz Mountain Lookout** - Gilman Road, exit 698. Turn right and follow Gilman Road approximately 5 miles to road 35 N04. Turn left on the road 35N04. This steep, rocky, dirt road is not recommended for low clearance passenger vehicles. Travel approximately 5 miles to the locked gate. Due to rocky, slippery, steep terrain, the last quarter-mile section of road access to the lookout is for foot traffic only.

### Caves & Caverns

**Lake Shasta Caverns** - McCloud Arm, across from Holiday Harbor

**Samwell Cave** - McCloud Arm, across from Ellery Creek Campground

### Waterfalls

**Waters Gulch** - Sacramento Arm, near Packers Bay

**Bear Creek Falls** - Pit River Arm, near Arbuckle Flat

**Indian Creek Falls** - Sacramento Arm, near Gregory Beach

**Potem Falls** - Pit River Arm, near Pit 7 Dam

**Little Backbone Natural Waterslide** - Little Backbone, hike up Creek about 20 minutes

### Fishing

Shasta Lake Ranger Station - 530-275-1587

Please check the current California Fishing Regulations to determine limits and any restrictions. Local Bait Shops can be a good source of information as to where the fish are biting and on which bait.

There is no fishing allowed from Boat Ramps or Courtesy Docks. (36CFS261.58.b)
